Document Checklist for Internationally Educated Dietitians

- Have World Education Services (WES) send credential assessment results and university transcripts directly to NSDA.
- Submit NSDA's online 'initial' application form.
 - Upload photocopy of birth certificate or passport.
 - Upload verification of name change (e.g. copy of marriage certificate) - if applicable.
- Official letter from the program director of your practicum program sent directly to NSDA. The letter should describe the following information:
 - Length of the program
 - Practicum settings (e.g. hospital, long term care facility, clinic)
 - Types of experiences
 - Supervision (who supervises and evaluates the students e.g. whether a dietitian)
- If English is not your first language or your primary education was not in English, have English proficiency test results sent directly to NSDA from the testing agency.
- Verification of good standing from dietetic regulatory/licensing organization sent directly to NSDA.

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
